

Preparation of Manuscripts

REFERENCES

Bibliographic citations in the text should appear by author's names and year of publication. Examples are as follows: Knauer & Lehle (1994) or (Knauer & Lehle, 1994), Gow *et al.* (1993) or (Gow *et al.*, 1993). In the reference list they should be organized in alphabetic order. In full-length papers and reviews the references should contain full titles of the articles referred to. In short communications the reference titles should be omitted. First and last page numbers are to be quoted.

References for journals and books should be in the following style:

Knauer R, Lehle LL. (1994) The *N*-oligosaccharyl-transferase complex from yeast. *FEBS Lett.*; **344**: 83-6.

Towbin H, Staechelin T, Gordon J. (1979) Electrophoretic transfer of proteins from polyacrylamide gels to nitrocellulose sheets: procedure and some

applications. *Proc Natl Acad Sci U S A.*; **76**: 4350-5.

Gow NAR, Swoboda R, Bertram G, Goodday GW, Brown AJP. (1993) Key genes in the regulation of dimorphism of *Candida albicans*. In *Dimorphic fungi in biology and medicine*. Vanden Bossche H, Odds FC, Kerridge A. eds, pp 61-71. Plenum Press, New York, London.

Articles accepted for publication in other journals are cited in the reference list as "in press". Data in preparation or only submitted are referred to in the text ("unpublished data") or in a footnote on the same page, not in the reference list. The same concerns personal communications. Written permission to quote personal communication from its author(s) must be provided. Extensive reference to personal communication or unpublished results should be avoided.

Submission of Manuscripts

Electronic Manuscript

The final accepted version of the manuscript should be submitted by e-mail. Text should be prepared in an

IBM word-processor (Word for Windows version 6.0 or higher; or *.rtf). Figures are acceptable in the following formats: *.cdr (text converted to curves), *.tif, *.eps, *.psd, *.jpg (not less than 300 dpi).

Proof Reading

The galley proofs are sent as the pdf file to the given by the authors e-mail address. The authors should check the proofs for any errors introduced in the editing of the manuscript and return the corrected pages to the editorial office within three days. No changes

other than corrections of printer's errors should be made at this stage. If the authors cannot correct the proofs personally, they should authorize someone else to do so. The proofs are to be sent by e-mail either as the notes to the pdf file or as the list of corrections.
