

How to get to the Scientific Centre of the Polish Academy of Sciences in Vienna (Boerhaavegasse 25, A – 1030 Wien) from the airport

The best – and cheapest – way is to take the **Schnellbahn S7** (city train), direction: Wien Mitte, Floridsdorf . In the arrival hall you will find a sign leading you directly to the platform of the train.

Please get off at **Rennweg**, one stop before Wien-Mitte. We would not recommend you to take the City-Airport Train (green, CAT is written on it) as it does not stop at Rennweg. Train S7 leaves from the Vienna International Airport every half an hour the whole day long , i.e. 8:10, 8:40, ... 18:40, 19:10 ...). From the airport to Rennweg it takes 22 minutes.

You can buy a ticket at the ticket machine at the platform. As your destination, please choose (preselected destination) **Wien-Mitte**. The price for the ticket: 3.00 Euro.

After having arrived a Rennweg, leave the station and cross the street Ungargasse, then follow the street Rennweg to the east, i.e. the house numbers have to increase. At the left side, you will pass a small church (with a tiny garden in front of it), then you will see a shop BILLA at the corner Rennweg – Boerhaavegasse. Please turn left, the third building at the right hand is the **Scientific Centre of the Polish Academy of Sciences in Vienna (No. 25)**. Please ring the door bell, it will be opened for you.

The distance from the train station Rennweg to the Scientific Centre of the Polish Academy of Sciences in Vienna is about 500 m (7 min., average walking speed). You can also take tram No. 71 (every 5 – 6 minutes), direction: Kaiserebersdorf, then you have to get off at Kleistgasse (one stop). You don't need a new ticket, as the one you bought at the airport is still valid.
