

How to get to the Polish Academy of Sciences Scientific Centre in Vienna (Boerhaavegasse 25, A-1030 Wien) from Südbahnhof

When you leave **Südbahnhof** with the main entrance, you will see a tram stop just in front of the railway station. Take a **tram "0"** in the east direction (**Praterstern**) i.e. to the right.

Go two stops and get off at **Rennweg**.

From there you can take another **tram "71"** in the direction south-east (**Kaiserebersdorf**) and go one stop, but it is simpler to walk about 6 minutes along the street **Rennweg**.

When you see a small church at the left hand side, you will have to turn left just behind the church – this small street is **Boerhaavegasse**. Our Centre (Boerhaavegasse 25) is in the third building on the right hand side, opposite to the church.

You will see a stone plate with a Polish/German inscription “Polska Akademia Nauk ...” at the entrance to the building. Please push the button marked with an arrow. The electrical lock will be opened by a member of our staff, who will meet you and give you keys to the rooms. Our guests are welcome from 7 a.m. till 11 p.m.

It is recommended to have a look at our web site www.viennapan.org before your travel - you can find a small map there.

One single ticket (1.5 EUR) is needed for the tram, it can be used also in the second tram. There are special machines for the automatic purchase of tickets in the main hall of Südbahnhof (they are painted red and have instructions in many languages on the screen).

You should stamp your ticket in an "Entwerter" (small red box) after entering the first tram. You need NO extra ticket for your luggage.
